












Asynchronous Assessment T00|5& Strategies





Pros of Asynchronous Assessment

- Flexible time to process and complete assessments
- Not as internet dependent
- Built-in reflection
- Can be collaborative
- More focused on the process
- Demonstrate understanding



Best Practices Around Group Work

- Assess the performance of the group and it's individual members
- Use timestamps to gauge participation
- Give regular feedback to the group and individuals
- Give students the opportunity to evaluate themselves
- Considering adjusting grades based on peer evaluations




