5 ways to use memes with students

I love memes and enjoy sharing them on Facebook, Twitter or even emailing them to friends and coworkers. But until recently, it never occurred to me to use a meme generator, a fun communication tool, in the classroom.

For those who aren't familiar with them, memes (pronounced *meemz*) are a cultural element or system of behavior that is passed from one individual to another. They are often represented by an image with a brief bold caption overlaid and shared on social media to capture attention or elicit a quick laugh.

One night while working hard on my lesson plans, my 14-year-old son decided to poke fun at me by sending me a text with the following meme that he created:

Meme 1

I had to laugh because it was so true. And in that moment, I had an epiphany. What if I asked my students to create math-themed memes? The next day I set out the criteria

for The Math Meme Project:

- The memes had to be their own creations.
- They could be about any algebra topic or about my class in general
- Students could submit up to three.
- They could submit their creations to my school email.
- They had three weeks to turn them in.

Do Memes Violate Copyright?

Copyright Meme Makers

If a composition is transformed into a completely new work, such as a parody song, it can be considered fair use and exempt from copyright law. But under fair use guidelines, the borrowed work must not detract from the profits of the original work, and it can't act as a substitute for the original if it were broadcast on the radio or in a club.
