LEVELS OF ENGAGEMENT

1 AUTHENTIC ENGAGEMENT

Students attach personal meaning and value to the activity

e.g. Discussing a topic of personal interest

2 RITUAL COMPLIANCE

Students only engage because of extrinsic outcomes or value

e.g. Earning a high grade or score

3 PASSIVE COMPLIANCE

Students only try hard to avoid negative consequences

e.g. Not failing the course

4 RETREATISM

Students are disengaged and make no attempt to comply


e.g. Observed texting on phone or generally 'checked out'

5 REBELLION

Students refuse to do the assigned task and act disruptive


